

Ruffled-edged Farmhouse-style Dishcloth Pattern

(for beginners)



Materials:

Sugar n' Cream 4 ply cotton yarn
5 mm crochet hook
scissors
tapestry needle
Safety pins or stitch markers

Directions:

- 1.) Slip knot on hook, chain 32
- 2.) Skip first two chains, work half-double crochet stitch into next 30 chains
- 3.) Chain 2, turn work, half-double crochet into next 30 stitches. Repeat this step until dishcloth is square.
- 4.) Turn work, chain 2 and 2 double crochet in first stitch. Slip stitch in next stitch. 3 double crochet in next stitch. Repeat slip stitch and 3 double crochet in alternating stitches all around the dishcloth to create a scalloped edge. You should have 12-13 scallops for each side. (I show how to work in unconventional spaces in the video.)
- 5.) Finish with a slip knot when scallops meet. Weave in ends.
